EWGA Chapters are invited to "adopt a girl"

Be one of 33 EWGA Chapters who will personally help one of Renee's 35 girls this year (The EWGA Foundation Board and the EWGA Staff have already adopted two girls).

The girls range in age 7 to 15. You can help them start their school year off this fall by providing basic school supplies and a golf outfit. We all know how a new outfit can lift your spirits and buoy one's confidence! And let's not take for granted that starting school with the basics is something enjoyed by all students. Won't you "adopt" one of Renee's girls and be responsible for a smile that is sure to last all year long?

Here's how:

1. To be one of 33 Chapters to help Renee's girls this year, send an email to foundation@myewga.com indicating your intent to adopt one (or more) of Renee's girls. In this email, include your Chapter name and the Chapter contact name for this effort.
2. We will assign one of the girls to you and send your Chapter contact an email confirming the "adoption", providing the name of the girl, her age, her clothing size, and a recommended school supply list. We hope that after a week or two ALL the girls will be adopted, **so please act fast.**
3. Once you receive from AHQ the information on your girl and the list of items for your Chapter to collect (**items are to be new vs. used**), your Board can work on collecting the modest list of low cost items and/or put out the word to your membership and watch the magic of giving spirits happen.
4. After you have all the items, pack them up and ship them to the headquarters office of EWGA, attn: *Drive for Dreams*, with the girl's name clearly indicated on the box. You may also want to write a note of encouragement and include it in the box – personalizing it for the deserving girl. **Deadline for receipt of boxes is September 1, 2009.**
5. Finally, remember to include in the box your EWGA Chapter's name, and contact name and address so that the girl can write you a thank you note. Renee teaches these girls a lot of life lessons beyond golf – like the graciousness of writing thank you notes!
6. And whether you adopt a girl or not, if you can donate \$25 to the EWGA Foundation to help with the shipping, the EWGA and Renee's girls will be most grateful!

This is your chance to personally impact the life of a young girl and give her not only the gift of golf but the gift of showing that people care! Let your big hearts shine and give!
